The Green and Wildflower Meadow

The Green in Abbots Ann is a former School Field leased to the Parish Council to provide an open space for the benefit of villagers who exercise their dogs, play football and generally enjoy the open space.

One area has been selected to provide a Wildflower Meadow enhancing the biodiversity in the village whilst providing a pretty addition to the site.

To help mark the location of the Wildflower Meadow, a small fence approximately 2 feet tall has been erected to identify the area and help other users ensure that footballs don't roll into it and dogs don't damage the plants. Two gates provide easy access to the site for those who wish to enter it, although most adults could simply step over the fence.

A public footpath runs along the northern side of The Green which is not impacted by the Wildflower Meadow, with an area wide enough to allow a tractor mower to pass by.
